The new menu for Term 2 is already on Parent Pay and you can book hot meals up until Christmas. Please place orders for the first week in Term 2 ASAP.

A final reminder that parent appointments take place on **Thursday 12th and Tuesday 17th October** in the village hall. If you have yet to make an appointment, please sign in to eSchools to book a slot to see your child's class teacher.

On Friday of this week, Nelson Class are holding their Cake Sale in the playground after school and FOS will be selling pre-loved uniform too. Please bring some spare change as all the money raised goes to Friends of School and providing additional resources and experiences for the children.
