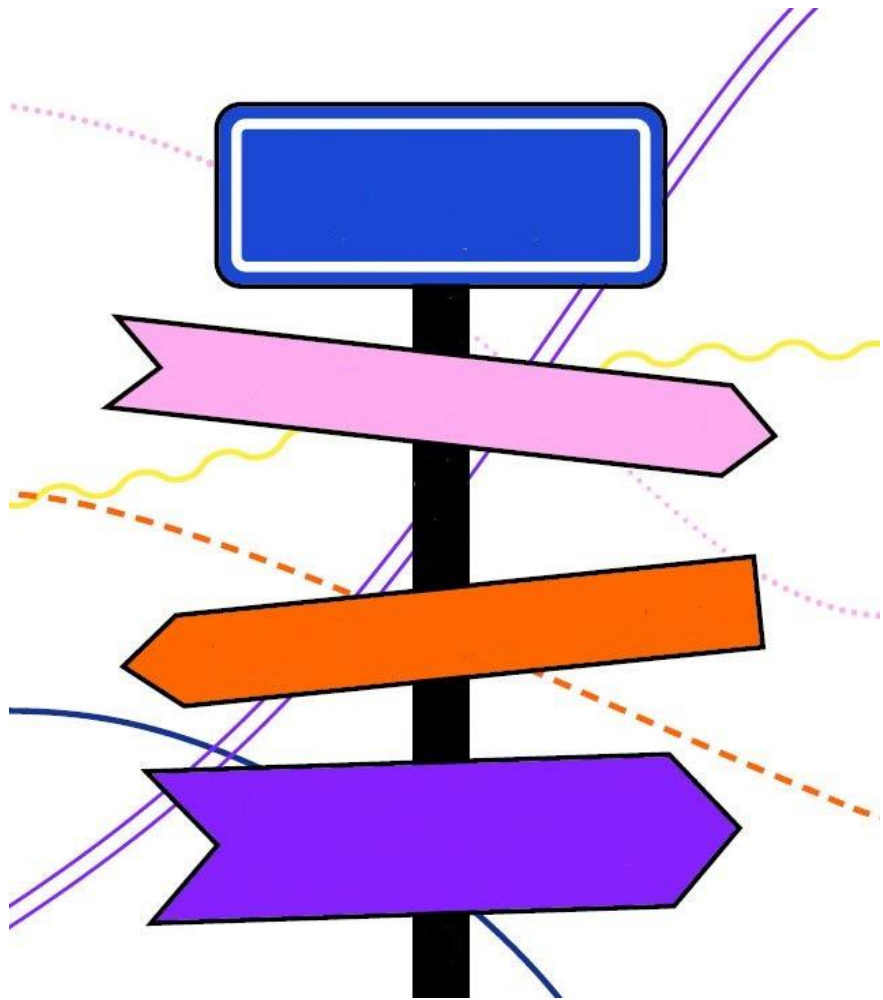
Please don't rush your work. The winners will be those that have thought about their ideas the most and have produced their work as carefully as they can.

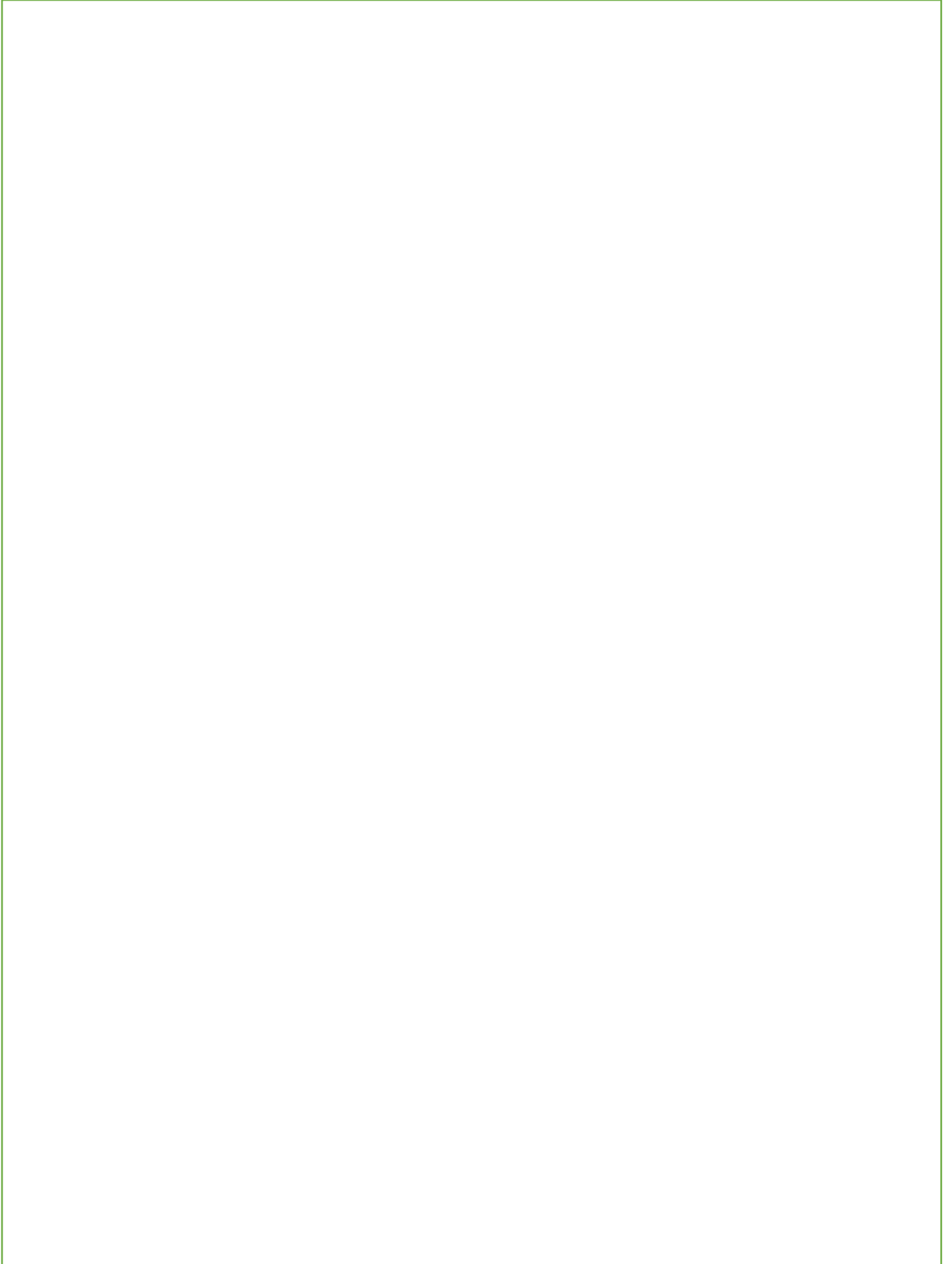
