It is Armistice Day on Saturday 11th November and we are holding our school Remembrance Service on Friday 10th November at 11.00am. Our Service will take place in the churchyard at the Graveside of the Commonwealth War Graves. Each child will lay a silk poppy on one of the graves and we will observe a minute's silence. You are very welcome to join us for our service if you wish.

On Tuesday 7th November, a representative from the Poppy Appeal is visiting school and will be selling poppies. They will visit each class, so please send your child in with a small donation if you would like them to buy a poppy on this day.

Looking ahead, the week beginning Monday 13th November is National Anti-Bullying Week. We always celebrate this week in school as it gives us a valuable opportunity to talk about this important topic with the children. Our school theme for the week will be 'Connect with Kindness' and we will be thinking about all the ways that we can spread kindness throughout our school community.

Also during this week, on Tuesday 14th November, we are holding an English Curriculum Evening from 5.30 – 6.15pm. This year, the format for the evening will be slightly different. Class teachers will set-up a display of different English resources and examples of work for you to come and look at, a little bit like a market stall. You will be able to come into school, have a look through these and talk to class teachers, who will be available to answer any questions you may have, or provide you with advice.
